- I. CALL TO ORDER FOR BOARD MEETING: The meeting was called to order at 6:48 PM by President Mona DesRosiers

- Rapid Restoration Insurance deductible phase 1 / Remediation phase 2
 Additional Information:
- As of December 5th, four (4) units remain with unpaid roof loan balances totaling \$60,300.74. A notice of intent to foreclose will be sent out within days.
- Carry-over approximately \$120,000. Net owed to RRT approximately \$65,000, which represents \$5,000 deductible per building. We will be approving RRT payment of \$25,000 & we will still owe them \$40,000.
- VI. MANAGEMENT REPORT: Report submitted by Tim Hendrix; LCAM Ameri-Tech available upon request.
 - Motion by A. Valentine, second by T. Donohue to hire Greenberg Associates to file CTA
 information required by state of Florida at a cost of \$150. Motion passed; opposed B. Worms citing
 history of delays by Greenberg.

VIII. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Rapid Response Team Waiting for opinion from our attorney, Dan Greenberg to determine who is responsible for replacing dry wall.
- B. Motion by A. Valentine to create a *Condo Committee* chaired by Ron Finger to investigate viability of electrical outlets from saltwater intrusion, air quality, & chemicals used by RRT in Phase I of restoration. No second, motion died.
- C. Motion to chair Hurricane Relief Committee chaired by A. Valentine, no second, motion failed.
- D. Motion by A. Valentine to expedite testing of electrical outlets, arrange for industrial hygienist to test indoor quality and 'building envelope'. No second, motion failed
- E. Motion by JB Dickson, second by B. Worms to pay RRT \$25,000 for partial payment of cleanup. Motion passed; A. Valentine opposed.
- F. Motion by T. Donohue, second by B. Worms to table landscaping. Motion passed unanimously.

IX. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Insurance & Special Requirements
 - 1. Fire extinguisher inspection: Two estimates have been received: Piper-Fire: \$9.50/ extinguisher; Fire Master: \$6.90/extinguisher
 - 2. Insurance requires 54" latches for pool entrance gate & gates to private residences. Approximate costs: \$130/lock; labor 3 hours @ \$95/hour. Sign also required by water. One electrical panel needs to be tested & possibly replaced.
 - 3. Unit 504: large tree encroaching on property & damaging awning. Board will obtain two proposals: one to trim & one to remove.
 - 4. Flood Policy: motion by M. DesRosiers, second by T. Donohue to approve Flood Policy renewal; motion passed unanimously.
